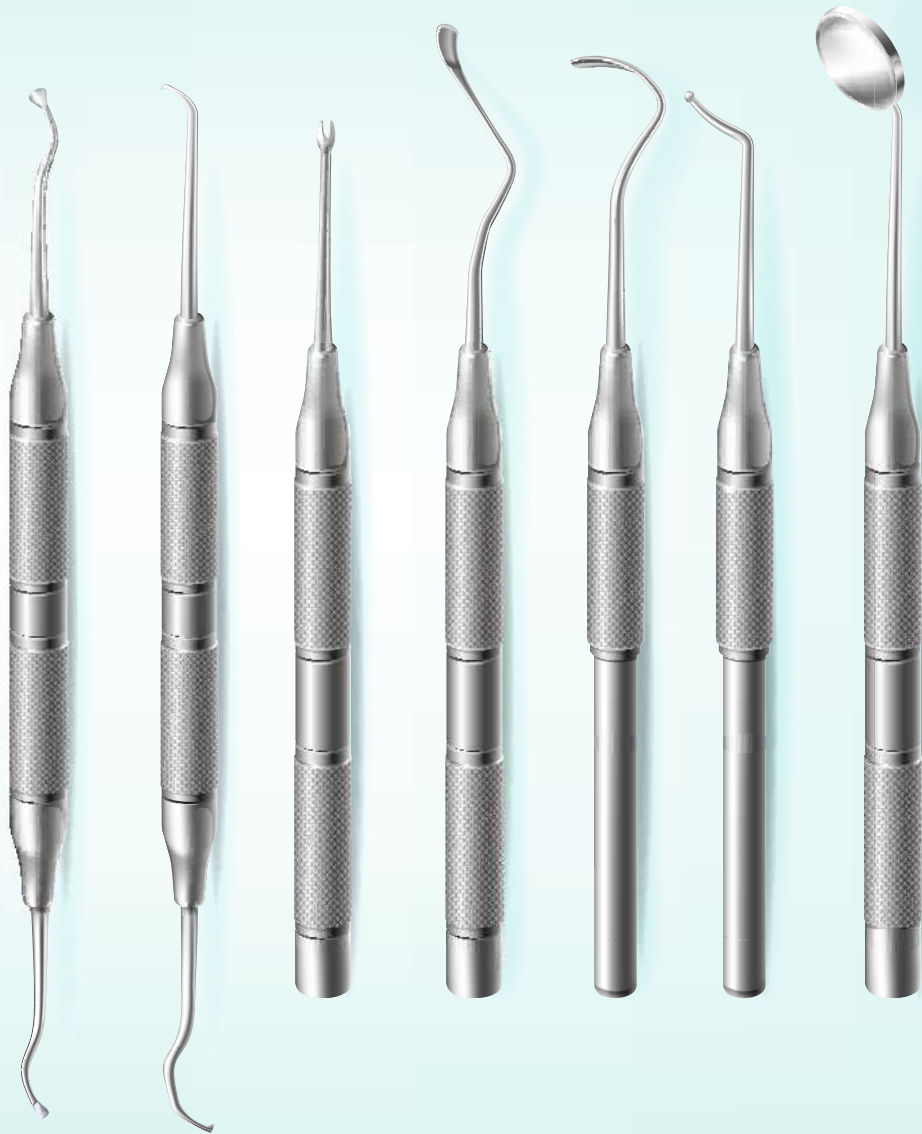
Chaudhry Muhammad Akram Teaching & Research Hospital also exists on campus for teaching & training of BDS students.

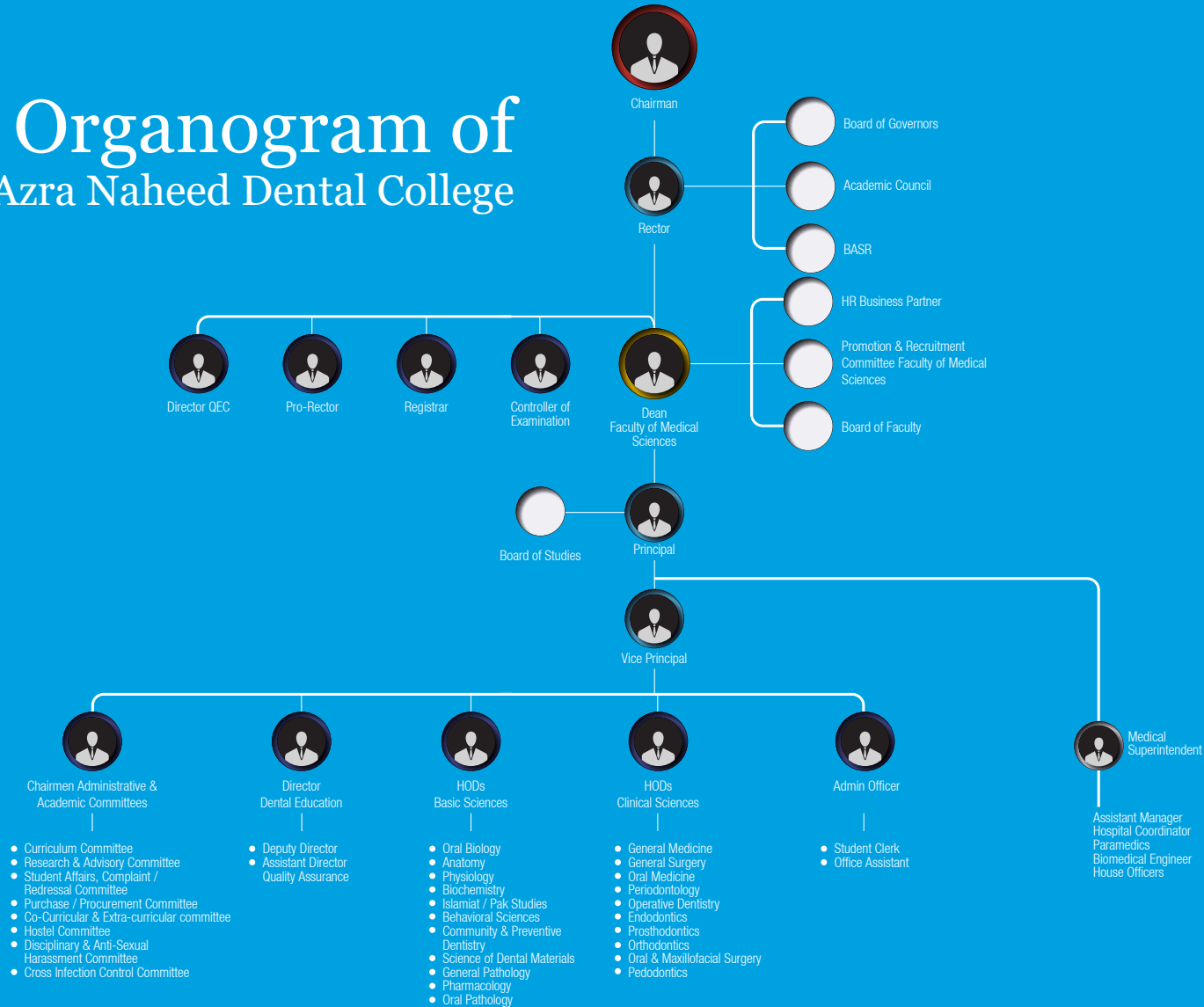

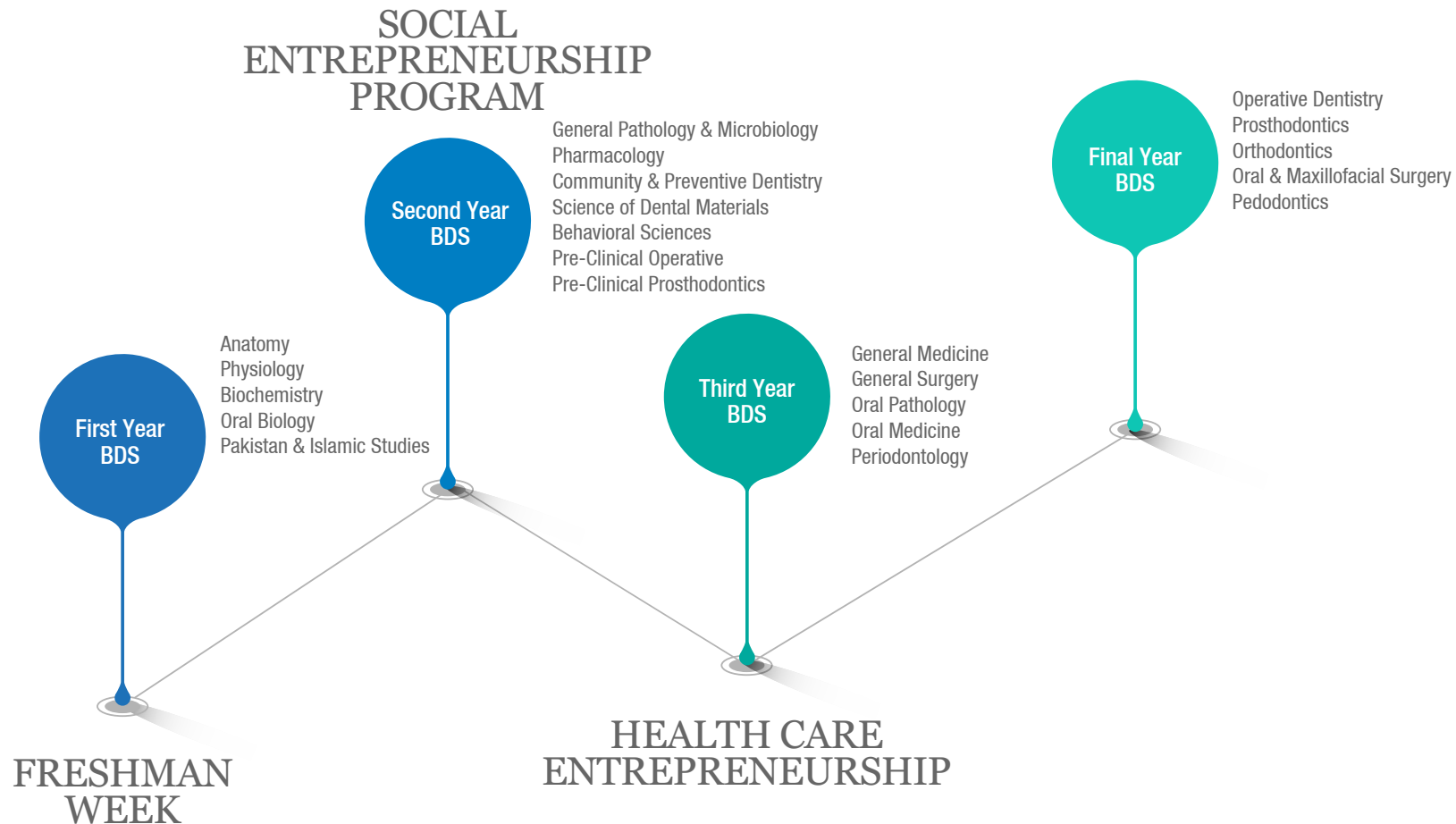

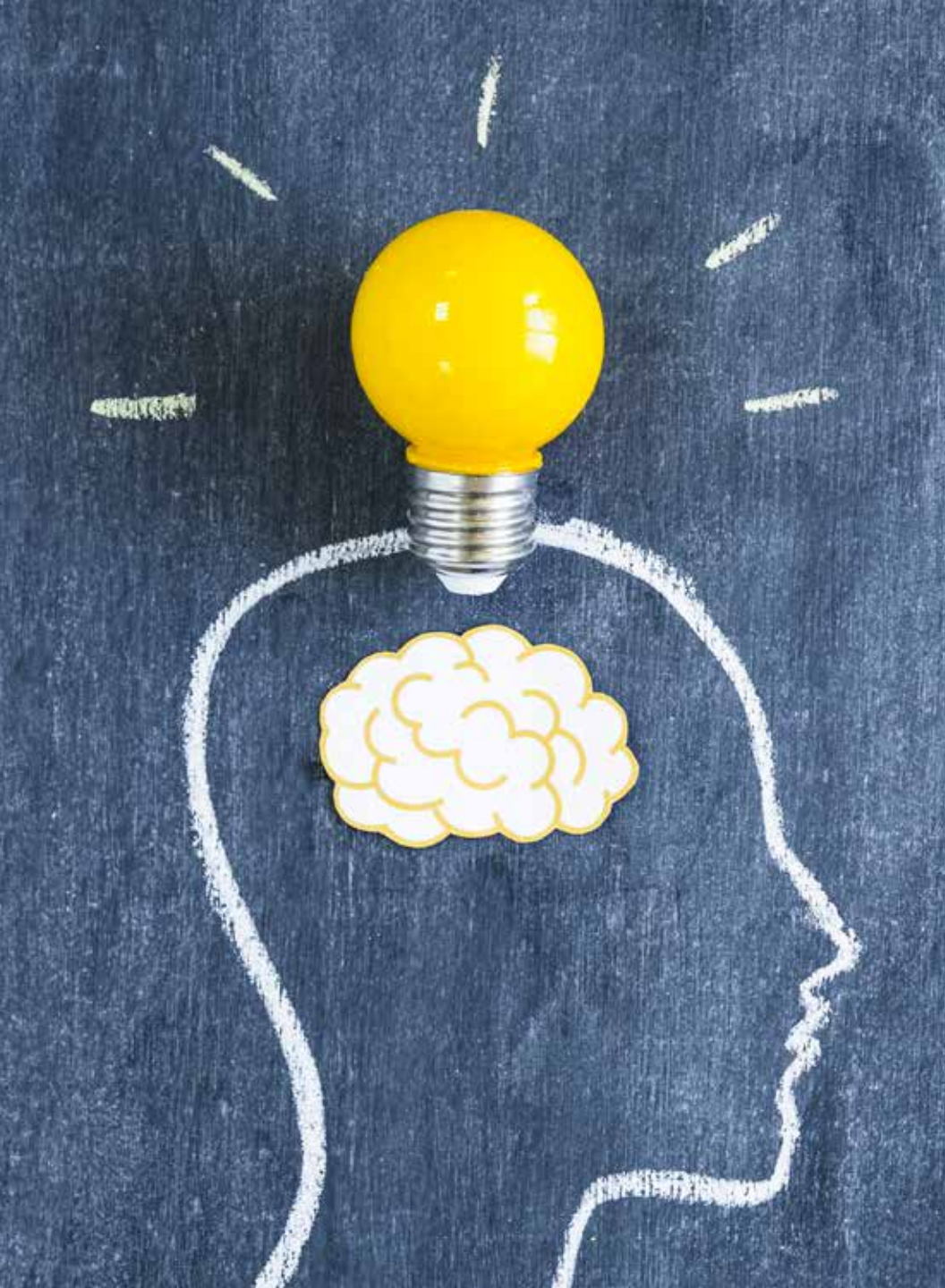

Department of Biochemistry

Biochemistry is the study of chemical reaction taking place in living tissues. It is essential to understand basic functions of the body. This study gives information regarding the functioning of cells at molecular level. It forms the basics of various fields of medicine like physiology, pharmacology, chemical pathology and toxicology. The tools for research in all branches of medical sciences are mainly biochemical in nature. Biochemistry is the most rapidly developing discipline in medicine. The major share of Nobel prizes in medicine has gone to research workers engaged in Biochemistry. In short, biochemistry plays a pivotal role in all aspects of medicine and dentistry.

Its curriculum covers all the aspects of body functioning system wise. The basic knowledge of Human Physiology is mandatory for thorough understanding of terminology and mechanisms of functioning of human body normally and to correlate it with Anatomy and Biochemistry. Human Physiology is the most important link between the Basic Sciences and Clinical Sciences especially clinical dentistry as it enables a doctor to discriminate between health and disease.

The discipline of Oral Biology deals with the structure and development of oral tissues, their inter-relationships and their relation to other organ systems. Various aspects of this subject include. Oral and dental anatomy, craniofacial and dental development, oral physiology, oral histology, tooth morphology and occlusion including relevant clinical considerations.

The rationale for Oral Biology is to provide focus for the additional Basic Health Science along with a basic knowledge of Oral Biology upon which clinical subjects of dentistry can be built. A wide range of interdisciplinary training, informational and support options are available to students. Faculty is challenged to develop innovative ways to present loads of information to students in a fashion that will encourage students to remain lifelong learners.

ADMISSION REGULATIONS FOR BDS PROGRAM

Admission in the BDS program of Azra Naheed Dental College will be made strictly in accordance with the admission regulations prescribed by the Pakistan Medical & Dental Council and Superior University, Lahore. Following are the regulation for governing admissions in the BDS program:

1. ELIGIBILITY:

Eligibility for this program follows the criteria set by the Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PMDC)

2. MERIT CALCULATION: All admissions shall be made strictly on merit , which shall be calculated as per following weightages:

- i. MDCAT 50 %
- ii. HSSC/F.Sc or equivalent 40%
- iii. Matriculation 10%

Note : The weightages assigned may vary as per instructions of PMDC or the requirements set by the Superior University, Lahore.

3. Application Procedure :

- 3.1 The admission process will be carried out through an online portal (<https://erp.superior.edu.pk/web/anmdc>) in a transparent manner. Students can submit their applications for admission when admissions are officially opened.
- 3.2 It is mandatory for each applicant to get registered for the Admission Test by paying the prescribed fee.
- 3.3 All entries must be made on the College portal. Any deliberate misrepresentation or non-provision of information may lead to disqualification from the admission process.

- 3.4 Admissions to MBBS and BDS programs will be conducted separately. Students must apply individually for each program they wish to pursue.
4. DISPLAY OF PROVISIONAL MERIT LIST: The College will publish a Provisional Merit List of all the applicants who will qualify the Admission Test and Interview conducted by the Admission Committee of Azra Naheed Dental College/ Superior University Lahore. The date of test and display of list shall be notified to the applicants separately.
5. OFFER OF ADMISSION: The Provisional Merit List represents an offer of admission to students drawn on the basis of merit. The offer shall be announced publicly through official website of the college. In case the applicant on merit number one does not deposit dues within the stipulated time period, offer shall stand cancelled, and admission will be offered to the candidate next on merit.

6. ADMISSION DEADLINE:

- 6.1 All admissions to BDS Program must be completed by or before the final date announced by the College.
- 6.2 The final list of admitted students will be submitted to the PMDC on the prescribed format through the PM&DC Online Portal as per deadlines.
- 6.3 All admissions shall be finalized as per deadlines announced by the PMDC.

7. **VACANT SEATS:** Any seats that remain unfilled after the admission process will remain vacant, and there will be no transfers permitted in the 1st Year of BDS program.

8. **MULTIPLE ADMISSIONS:** Students who have accepted admission to ANDC must disclose if they have accepted admission offer from any other college.

9. **SUBMISSION OF CERTIFIED LIST:** A certified list of admitted students will be provided to the Pakistan Medical & Dental Council by the Superior University within sixty (60) days of the close of admissions, after verifying the high school

leaving certificate and other necessary credentials.

- 10. MAXIMUM SEAT LIMIT:** PMDC has prescribed 50 seats for BDS. ANDC will not admit students beyond the maximum allocated seats.

11. PHYSICAL MEDICAL EXAMINATION

All students must undergo a physical medical examination upon admission, which may be repeated if necessary. Medical defects are addressed by the college hospital, with serious issues reported to parents or guardians.

12. FEE AND CHARGES

- 12.1 The college has provided a detailed breakdown of tuition fees, non-refundable admission fees, hostel fees, transport charges, and other applicable charges for the 2023-24 session. These fees are cumulative and non-negotiable for the entire program duration.
- 12.2 Charges for optional services, such as hostel accommodation, mess/food, transport, and medical insurance, will only be applied when students avail of these services.
- 12.3 The college commits not to charge any amount beyond the maximum charges notified to the Council, including any enhanced values.
- 12.4 The final fee structure and optional charges for students enrolling in the 2023 session are available on the college's website (www.andc.superior.edu.pk).

13. CONFIRMATION OF ADMISSION

- 13.1 Admission for selected students will be confirmed only after they deposit the prescribed admission, tuition, and other fees within three days of the announcement of results. Unconfirmed seats will be offered to candidates on the waiting list.
- 13.2 Upon admission, students are required to submit their original F.Sc, Matric, and other certificates to the college. Copies of these certificates will be sent to the relevant Board/University/

institution for verification. Any discrepancies in the documents will result in expulsion, with fees and dues forfeited.

14. REFUND POLICY:

No refund shall be made, if the applicant opts to discontinue at the College of the Superior University.

ACADEMIC AND DISCIPLINARY RULES

1. ATTENDANCE

Students must maintain a minimum attendance of 75% in lectures, practical sessions, SGDs (Small Group Discussions), and tutorials to be eligible for University Examinations.

2. CLASSROOM

- 2.1 When the teacher enters the classroom, students are expected to maintain silence and show utmost respect for the teachers.
- 2.2 Students are not permitted to leave the lecture room without the teacher's permission or until the class is officially dismissed.
- 2.3 Roll call will be taken immediately after the assembly of the class. Students arriving late without a valid excuse accepted by the teacher will be marked as absent. Any classroom misbehavior will be promptly reported to the Head of Department by the teacher, and further action will be taken by the Principal as deemed appropriate.

3. DISCIPLINARY RULES

3.1 HOSPITAL DUTIES

- 3.1.1 Clinical students must adhere to hospital rules. Any offenses, neglect of duty, or failure to carry out assigned duties may result in disciplinary action, including suspension from attending specific

departments or hospital for up to three months or the imposition of appropriate fines.

- 3.1.2 Leave applications for students on hospital duty must be submitted through the Incharge Registrar/medical officer, Professor/Head of Department, and to the Principal.
- 3.1.3 Punctuality is required for clinical teaching and ward duty.

4. CLASS EXAMINATION

- 4.1 Students are prohibited from bringing textbooks, notes, manuscripts, or mobile phones into the examination hall. Violations will lead to strict disciplinary action.
- 4.2 Any student found violating examination rules or engaging in unfair practices may be expelled from the examination, with the case referred to the college disciplinary committee.
- 4.3 Latecomers arriving more than 15 minutes after the start of the exam, will not be allowed to enter the examination hall.

5. LEAVE

- 5.1 All absences from college, except for sick leave, will be marked as absent.
- 5.2 Sick leave requires a medical certificate from an authorized medical officer appointed by the college principal, except when the student is already on leave out of the station.
- 5.3 Medical certificates do not condone attendance deficiencies.
- 5.4 Students must not leave the station without the principal's permission.
- 5.5 Absence without leave for two consecutive weeks will result in removal from the college roll.

6. STUDENT'S MEDICAL CERTIFICATE AND TREATMENT

- 6.1 Non-boarders must obtain a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner.
- 6.2 Boarders, including those on hospital duty, require a medical certificate signed by a college professor/associate professor/assistant professor.
- 6.3 Medical certificates must be provided promptly and specify the nature of illness and the recommended period of leave.
- 6.4 Students who fall ill will receive treatment from a designated medical officer. Hospital medicines will be provided upon prescription. Students requiring hospitalization will have access

to the general ward.

7. PROVISION OF BOOKS etc.

Every student is responsible for procuring the prescribed textbooks and necessary study materials.

8. CORRESPONDENCE AND COMMUNICATION WITH COLLEGE PRINCIPAL

- 8.1 Students addressing the Principal via letter must do so individually, as joint applications are not permitted.
- 8.2 Students may directly approach the Principal, Professors, and Staff with their concerns and grievances, if any.
- 8.3 Harassment/ Gender Abuse or discrimination cases must be reported to the Principal in accordance with Superior University's policies on the matter.
- 8.4 Hostel-related issues should be reported to the Chief Warden, with the option to involve the Principal if necessary.

9. GENERAL DISCIPLINE RULES

- 9.1 Students must maintain order and discipline within the college premises.
- 9.2 Smoking is strictly prohibited within the college premises, in accordance with government ordinances.
- 9.3 Games are not to be played during college or hospital duty hours.
- 9.4 Displaying and distributing partisan or political materials within the college, hostels, or hospital premises is not allowed.
- 9.5 Possession of firearms or weapons within the college, hostels, or hospital premises is strictly prohibited.
- 9.6 Irregularities, neglect of duties, and breaches of discipline should be reported to the principal by the respective professors or staff members.
- 9.7 Students entrusted with college property are responsible for its preservation. Damaged or lost property must be replaced or reimbursed.
- 9.8 All cases of violation of discipline will be dealt with in accordance with Superior Univer-

city's Discipline Policy.

10. OFFENCES AND PUNISHMENTS

- 10.1 Offenses occurring within the college, hospital, or hostel premises may be referred to the college disciplinary committee, appointed by the Academic Council.
- 10.2 The college disciplinary committee, comprising professors, will review cases and recommend appropriate disciplinary actions to the principal.
- 10.3 Disciplinary actions may include:
 - 10.3.1 Apology, verbal or written, placed on the student's record.
 - 10.3.2 Putting on probation upto one year with potential expulsion for continued misconduct.
 - 10.3.3 Fines up to Rs. 10,000 and potential suspension or cessation of scholarships.
 - 10.3.4 Suspension from college rolls for a maximum of two weeks (excluding any prior suspension of up to 10 days by the college principal) pending an investigation.
 - 10.3.5 Expulsion from college for up to one year and rustication in case of repeated violations. Provided further that expulsion entails a five-year ban from university examinations and will not be readmitted before the end of punishment.
 - 10.3.6 Students will remain under the Principal's disciplinary jurisdiction until the Final Professional BDS examination.
- 10.4 All appeals against the decision of Discipline Committee will lie before the Principal, who will have the authority to remit fines and punishments imposed as fines only. However, in case of grave offenses and punishments, all appeals will be heard and decided by the University Management.
 - 10.4.1 Appeals of grave nature must be routed through the office of Principal alongwith his comments on the matter.
 - 10.4.2 The decision of the authorities as specified above will be final.

11. COLLEGE SPORTS

Students may participate in various sports according to their preferences, with game facilities provid-

ed by the college management. Additional subscriptions may apply for students participating in more than one game or sports club.

12. COLLEGE SESSION & COURSES OF STUDIES

The college follows the academic schedule, courses of studies, and examination systems as per Superior University and Pakistan Medical & Dental Council guidelines.
